2. Purpose and scope

This dossier summarises the available documentation relating to primary packaging and transport cartons used for dry and fresh pasta. Technical information is derived from manufacturers' documents and supplemented by Casa Prencipe's operating data.

Packaging families covered:

- Anico paper/PP bags for Casa Prencipe dry pasta, small and large cut variants;
- Silvano Plast PA/PE bags for flavoured dry pasta, fresh pasta and customer-branded production;
- SIFA corrugated transport cartons identified in Section 5.

This dossier applies exclusively to the configurations identified in Sections 4 and 5 and documented by the attachments listed in Section 9.

3. Regulatory framework considered

- Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR);
- Regulations (EC) 1935/2004 and (EC) 2023/2006;
- Regulation (EU) 10/2011, as amended;
- Regulation (EU) 2024/3190, where applicable;
- Decision 97/129/EC and Italian environmental-labelling legislation.

Casa Prencipe meets the definition of a micro-enterprise. Since its packaging suppliers are established in the European Union, the supplier is considered the manufacturer for the purposes of Article 15(12) PPWR for packaging designed or manufactured under the Casa Prencipe name or trademark. This dossier is an information summary and does not replace the manufacturer's technical documentation or EU declaration of conformity.

Anico and Silvano Plast have issued food-contact declarations referring to Regulations (EC) 1935/2004, (EC) 2023/2006 and (EU) 10/2011, including information on overall and specific migration and the stated conditions of use.

The cartons are not intended for direct contact with pasta. SIFA documentation states recyclability according to UNI EN 13430, 60% recycled fibre and compliance with the heavy-metal limit.

Typical configuration: 10 packs per carton, generally 500 g each. Cartons per pallet vary and average approximately 56.
