Compliance of the laminated film is based on the declarations of compliance issued by the manufacturers of the constituent materials and on the absence of significant chemical modifications during the lamination process.

Migration

Based on the available information, the overall migration limit complies with 10 mg/dm². Substances subject to specific migration limits comply with Regulation (EU) 10/2011, assuming the conventional ratio of 6 dm²/kg of food.

Substances not intentionally used

- Bisphenol A (BPA)
- Phthalates and adipates
- Latex
- GMOs
- Allergens (Regulation (EU) 1169/2011)
- Organotin compounds
- Halogenated dioxins
- Melamine and cyanuric acid

Limitations

- This declaration refers exclusively to the laminated film in the condition in which it is supplied.
- It does not extend to subsequent processing (printing, cutting, sealing, etc.) not controlled by Silvano Plast.
- It remains valid unless the material composition, production process or applicable legislation changes.
